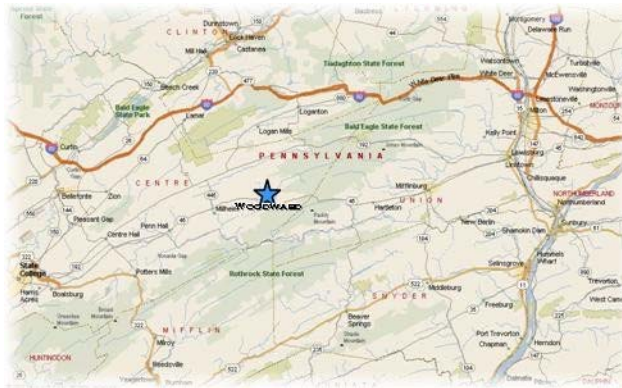

DIRECTIONS

FROM I-80 WEST

Take Bellefonte Exit 161. Take Exit 81 to Pleasant Gap-- Rt.26 South-West. Follow to second light in Pleasant Gap, turn left onto Rt. 144 for 5 miles. After having passed through Centre Hall, you'll come to the intersection of Rt. 144 and Rt. 45. Turn left onto Rt. 45 East. Go 17 miles. After **passing** Woodward Gymnastics Camp, turn left onto Cemetery Road. **PLEASE NOTE:** You must pass the Woodward Gymnastics Camp first before turning onto Cemetery Road. There are two Cemetery Roads. This is the second one. Go 8/10 mile. At the T, turn right onto Jackson Hill Road. You'll see a big red barn and the Guest Lodge on the left.

FROM I-80 EAST

Take the Lewisburg Exit 210A onto Rts. 11-15 South 7 miles to Lewisburg. Turn right onto Rt. 45 West. Go 25 miles through the village of Woodward. Upon leaving Woodward, take an immediate right onto Cemetery Road. Go 8/10 mile At the T, turn right onto Jackson Hill Road. You'll see a big red barn and the Guest Lodge on the left. Pine Creek Suite is the front unit. Hidden Pond is the side unit.

FROM RTS. 11-15

Take Rts. 11-15 to Lewisburg. At Lewisburg, take Rt. 45 West. Proceed 25 miles. After passing through Woodward, turn right onto Cemetery Rd. Go 8/10 mile. At the T, turn right onto Jackson Hill Road. You'll see a big red barn and the Guest Lodge on the left. Pine Creek Suite is the front unit. Hidden Pond is the side unit.

FROM I-99

Take I-99 to US 220 North East. Take US 322 East. Continue on US 322 East around State College. Take the Old Fort Exit. Turn left onto Rt. 45 East. Proceed 25 miles. After **passing** Woodward Gymnastics Camp, turn left onto Cemetery Road. **PLEASE NOTE:** You must pass the Woodward Gymnastics Camp first before turning onto Cemetery Road. There are two Cemetery Roads. This is the second one. Go 8/10 mile. At the T, turn right onto Jackson Hill Road. You'll see a big red barn and the Guest Lodge on the left. Pine Creek Suite is the front unit. Hidden Pond is the side unit.

FROM HARRISBURG

Take Rt. 322-Rt. 22 North towards Lewistown. After Lewistown, continue on Rt. 322 towards State College. After passing through the Seven Mountains, turn Right onto Rt. 144 North at Potters Mills. Proceed 4 miles to Intersection of Rt. 144 and Rt. 45. Take Rt. 45 East. Go 17 miles. After **passing** Woodward Gymnastics Camp, turn left onto Cemetery Road. **PLEASE NOTE:** You must pass the Woodward Gymnastics Camp first before turning onto Cemetery Road. There are two Cemetery Roads. This is the second one. Go 8/10 mile. At the T, turn right onto Jackson Hill Road. You'll see a big red barn and the Guest Lodge on the left. 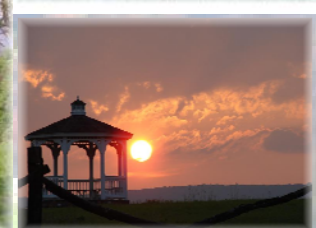
Pine Creek Suite boasts 4 bedrooms, living room, fully equipped kitchen, electric fireplace, front porch, and 2 full baths.
